### Classes

Dearborn Adult Education is offering GED Preparation classes to those wanting to prepare for the GED test. Classes focus on the five areas of reading, writing, social studies, math, and science.

### Eligibility

- GED students must be 20 years or older as of September 1, 2009.
- Students must be able to read and write English at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level and possess 9<sup>th</sup> grade math skills.
- Students possessing a high school diploma must pay a tuition of \$150.

### Class Schedules

**DAY classes** are two-hour classes that meet Monday through Friday beginning Monday, September 14, and ending Friday, December 11, 2009.

**EVENING classes** are three-hour classes that meet Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Classes begin Tuesday, September 8, and end Thursday, December 17, 2009.

### Fees

In addition to the \$20 non-refundable registration and assessment fee, there will be a \$50 fee to cover the use of equipment and materials.
