### **Classes**

ESL - English As A Second Language

Prepare to take the GED Test.

HSC – High School Completion - Earn credit  
toward a High School Diploma.

*\*ESL and GED classes are free pending state and federal funding.*

### **Eligibility**

Students enrolling in Adult Education classes must be 20 years or older as of September 1, 2009 and must not be currently enrolled in a high school.

### **Fees**

There will be a \$20 non-refundable registration and assessment fee due at the time of registration for all classes.

High School Completion and GED classes have additional fees that are listed on their appropriate pages.

### **Registration**
